### II<sup>nd</sup> Basic Neuropathology & Neuroanatomy Course for ECVN and ACVIM residents and trainees in Veterinary Neurosciences

In November 08, the first basic Neuropathology and Neuroanatomy course was organized by Dr. Kaspar Matiasek at the Animal Health Trust, Newmarket, UK. All the attendants recognized the quality and interest of this theoretical and practical course together with the good atmosphere and time spent during these days. At that time we decided that further editions should be organized in different European and American locations.

The second edition will take place next November. It will be held at the Veterinary Faculty of **Barcelona**, SPAIN, during the last week of November and the first week of December. It will be organized by the Department of Animal Medicine and Surgery of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona. The responsible of the course and in charge of the neuropathology part, will be **Dr. Martí Pumarola**, DVM, Dipl. ECVP. The teaching staff will also include **Dr. Sonia Añor**, DVM, Dipl. ECVN, she will be giving the clinical and neurological sessions. **Dr. Vicente Aigé**, DVM, will develop the neuroanatomy part. Other speakers will be also invited.
