



## **RESIDENCY IN NEUROLOGY & NEUROSURGERY**

Dick White Referrals (DWR) is seeking a dynamic, enthusiastic veterinary surgeon to undertake a three-year ECVN conforming residency in neurology/neurosurgery. The program will comprise a major training in small animal neurology/neurosurgery, clinical research, informal undergraduate teaching and external rotations in equine neurology. It is anticipated that the candidate will become eligible to sit the European College of Veterinary Neurology (ECVN) Diploma examination.

The successful candidate will join the DWR rapidly expanding team of RCVS, European and American specialist clinicians (x13) in a wide range of disciplines (anaesthesia, cardiology, clinical pathology, dermatology, diagnostic imaging, internal medicine, oncology, orthopedics, neurology/neurosurgery, soft tissue surgery and Camelids) and our team of residents (x10) and interns (x7). Dick White Referrals also has a unique and integrated collaboration and teaching program with The School of Veterinary Medicine and Science at the University of Nottingham.

The resident will be supervised by two ECVN Diplomates one based at DWR and one at the University of Nottingham. DWR has modern equipment including 24/7 availability, clinical pathology laboratory, physiotherapy unit, digital radiography, ultrasonography, fluoroscopy, electrodiagnostic, magnetic resonance imaging, easy and close access to CT and radiotherapy. Annual caseload for neurology is about 900, for neurosurgery about 200.

Applicants must have successfully completed a 12-month rotating internship or have equivalent experience during two years in small animal practice. The resident must be a member of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons or be eligible. The program is available from June 2012.

Application should include a letter of intent, curriculum vitae and two letters of reference.
