

Internship in Neurology and Neurosurgery

The Animal Health Trust (AHT) is a large UK-based veterinary charity dedicated to veterinary science and animal health and welfare. The small animal clinic is committed to providing the highest standards of patient care, and has an active programme of post-graduate training (internships and residencies) and clinical research supported by on site laboratories and scientists.

We are looking for a neurology/ neurosurgery intern to join our team. Our clinic contains all the facilities expected of an advanced referral clinic including 1.5T MRI, 16 Slice CT, electrophysiology equipment, a full range of neurosurgical equipment, fluoroscopy, scintigraphy, videoendoscopy, and minimally-invasive and orthopaedic surgical equipment.

The small animal clinic is a referral-only hospital with specialists in neurology, anaesthesia, diagnostic imaging, soft tissue surgery, internal medicine and oncology, ophthalmology, and dermatology. Further information can be found at <http://www.aht.org.uk/cms-display/sa.html>

The Internship will be for a period of 12 months and will provide training in clinical neurology, neurosurgery, electrodiagnostics, neuroimaging, neuroanatomy, neurophysiology, and neuropathology. In addition, duties will include daily contact with our specialists in other clinical disciplines. The successful candidate will be required to assist the neurology clinicians and residents in daily care of patients, consultations, diagnostic procedures, and neurosurgeries. The neurology intern will be encouraged to be involved in clinical research.

The successful candidate must be a graduated veterinarian and preferably have completed a one-year general internship and have work experience in general practice in the United Kingdom.

This position provides a salary of £19,037 per annum. Benefits include an excellent pension scheme with employer contribution up to 8%, 20 days annual leave plus Bank Holidays, 24 hour employee assistance scheme and CPD allowance.
